

1. Russia is the largest country by far, with a total area of about 17 million square kilometers.
2. Russia, country that stretches over a vast expanse of eastern Europe and northern Asia.
3. Along the 20,139-kilometre land frontier, Russia has boundaries with 14 countries: Poland and Lithuania (both via Kaliningrad Oblast), Norway, Finland, Estonia, Latvia, Belarus, Ukraine, Georgia, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, China, Mongolia, and North Korea.

4. There are different types of climate on the territory of the country. It is very cold in the North even in summer. The central part of the country has mild climate: winters are cold, springs and autumns are warm or cool, summers are hot and warm. In the South the temperature is usually above zero all year round, even in winter.
5. Moscow is the capital of Russia. It's more than 800 years old. Moscow was first mentioned in 1147. There are many theatres, museums, exhibitions and other places that are worth visiting — the State Tretyakov Gallery, The State Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts, the Cathedral of Saint Basil and others. The heart of the city is the Kremlin, of course.
6. The Tower of London was founded by Julius Caesar and in 1066 rebuilt by William the Conqueror.
7. So, first of all I would like to visit the Houses of Parliament. This building is situated on the bank of the river Thames and it is the seat of the British government. Then I want to go to the Madame Tussaud's Museum, because it is the most popular waxworks museum in the world.

15. The four main types of degrees are Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree, Doctorate (Ph.D.), and Vocational Qualifications.
16. The typical great public school—such as Eton, Harrow, Winchester, Westminster, Rugby, Shrewsbury, or Charterhouse
17. GCSE - General Certificate of Secondary Education Depending on the schools, students start studying for the GCSE exam in year 9 or year 10.
